

The Industry's Pre-season Playbook

March stands at the threshold of the season. Across much of Canada, the ground is still frozen, and the equipment is not yet running—but decisions are already in motion. Orders are being finalized. Service routes are taking shape. Hiring plans are being tested against reality. Early March is when preparation quietly turns into commitment.

That timing is exactly why this magazine is our annual Reference & Directory issue. It is designed to support decisions being made right now—before the pace accelerates and flexibility is lost. This is the issue that gets bookmarked, dog-eared, and revisited throughout the season as questions arise and priorities shift.

Across the industry, several themes continue to emerge as businesses prepare for the months ahead. Labour remains tight. Customers expect faster service and fewer problems. Margins leave little room for inefficiency. As a result, operators are closely examining systems that improve consistency, visibility, and reliability—without adding complexity. Those conversations are reflected throughout this issue.

In Transforming Pool Water Management (page 8), the rise of stand-alone pH and ORP controllers signals a practical evolution in residential pool care. As one technician explains, “Having a unit that both measures and doses makes it an incredible tool for our service offering.” For service companies preparing for peak season, this automation is less about innovation and more about prevention—keeping water balanced between visits and reducing reactive calls when schedules are full.

Financial discipline is another area coming into focus as the season approaches. In From Operations to Outcomes (page 16), Rachael Pritz underscores how digital tools support stability as volume increases. “The strongest return on investment typically comes from gains in labor efficiency, billing accuracy, technician productivity, inventory control, and payment collection,” she writes. Early March is when those systems either fall into place—or become pain points later.

Reliability extends beyond the backyard. The Hidden Lifeline of Aquatic Facilities (page 32) reminds us that preventive maintenance is most effective when planned ahead of demand. “A pool that is not maintained cannot serve its community,” the article notes—a reality that resonates as commercial facilities prepare for higher use with limited downtime.

Accessibility and long-term planning also inform early-season decisions. In Selecting the Right Rails, Ladders, and Lifts (page 24), Marley Cunningham reminds readers that access equipment choices are “about more than meeting minimum requirements.” Specifying these components early supports safety, usability, and operational confidence throughout the year.

As the season approaches, the industry’s focus shifts from ideas to execution. The tools, partners, and systems chosen now will determine how smoothly the months ahead unfold.

This Reference & Directory issue is intended to guide that process—before the water starts moving.



Transforming Pool Water Management

The Rise of Stand-alone pH and ORP Controllers

Maintaining pool water in proper balance has always been one of the most time-consuming tasks for both pool service technicians and homeowners. Maintaining optimal pH and oxidation-reduction potential (ORP) levels is essential for ensuring swimmer comfort, maximizing sanitizer efficiency, extending equipment longevity, and maintaining overall water clarity. Historically, chemical automation systems capable of accurately monitoring and dosing water were often complex, expensive, and designed primarily for commercial installations or advanced automation panels.

However, recent advances in sensor technology, microelectronics, and wireless connectivity have ushered in a new generation of simple, stand-alone

pH and ORP controllers. These units are specifically engineered for residential use, offering accuracy comparable to high-end commercial systems but with streamlined installation, intuitive app-based monitoring, and far more accessible pricing. As a result, pool service technicians now have a powerful new tool that allows them to maintain water chemistry more effectively—both during service visits and in the days between them.

A new era of chemical automation

Traditional chemical controllers often required integration with a larger automation system and a higher price tag. This discouraged many homeowners from adopting automated water

management and made the equipment difficult for technicians to sell.

“Our company has installed pH and ORP controllers in the past, but they have always been expensive and work best when coupled with other equipment like chlorinators,” says Josh Nelson, owner of the service company 4G Nelson Pools. “And because of the price point, it wasn’t easy for us to talk our customers into adding one of these units to the pool.”

However, Nelson recently discovered that new technological advances have brought simple, stand-alone pH and ORP controllers to the market, which not only measure pH and ORP but also provide the capability to dose the pool water as needed.

“Having a unit that both measures and doses makes it an incredible tool for our service offering,” says Nelson. “The best thing about it is that it has a lower price point, making it much easier to sell and install on most of the pools that we service.”

Many service technicians note that some of the latest stand-alone controllers have altered their approach to selling and installing pH and ORP

systems for residential pools. Thanks to improvements in microprocessors, sensor coatings, and firmware, these compact devices combine everything needed—probes, dosing capability, control logic—into a single, self-contained system. There is no need to purchase or connect a full automation panel. Techs mount the unit at the




equipment pad, install the sensors in the plumbing, set dosing limits, and the controller handles the rest. Nelson also notes that replacement parts for the newer units are significantly more cost-effective.

“If you need a replacement sensor for these new units, you are looking at \$47 to \$56 CAD (\$35 to \$40 USD) compared to \$207 to \$276 CAD (\$150 to \$200 USD) for the traditional, more commercial-grade units that have been on the market,” says Nelson. “This makes these products perfect for residential pool service, as you can actually put a few extra sensors on your service truck for when you need them.”

These residential systems still provide the essential functionality, which includes:

- Continuous real-time monitoring of pH and ORP
- Precise dosing of acid, liquid chlorine, CO₂, or liquid feed sanitizers
- Built-in alarms and safety shutdowns
- Calibration reminders and probe-health diagnostics
- Wireless connectivity for remote monitoring with an app

Despite their simplified design, the underlying technology is not simplistic. Modern pH and ORP probes are more stable and require less frequent calibration. Digital signal processing helps filter noise and produce more reliable readings. Temperature compensation is now standard on

many models, ensuring that chemical levels remain correct under varying weather conditions.

In short, these controllers offer the accuracy and control that were once available only to commercial pools—now in a package designed for residential backyards.

Stand-alone design: A game-changer for technicians

The independence from major automation platforms is one of the biggest reasons these new systems are gaining rapid popularity. Since these controllers operate independently of automation systems, homeowners can add chemical control without needing to invest in additional equipment.

"In our area, we have this problem with always controlling the pH, especially with pools that use salt chlorine generators, and it's such a chore to be adding acid manually," says Nelson. "The new pH units that both sense and dispense have really been a game changer for us."

For pool service technicians, this independence factor means:

- Faster installation—No electrical system integration with automation panels.
- Broader compatibility—Works with any pump, filter, or heater setup.
- Ideal for retrofits—A clean and easy upgrade without major equipment replacement needed.

Even more importantly, these stand-alone units give technicians control over the water chemistry independent of whatever equipment the homeowner already has. This flexibility makes chemical automation accessible to customers who want more stable water chemistry without upgrading their entire equipment pad.

"These units offer a simple flow indicator in the app that other more expensive systems don't offer," says Nelson. "Being able to see if the water isn't flowing tells me there is problem without having to wait for the next service call to find out and I can prioritize that job. While I'm checking the chemical readings in the app I can quickly see if the pump is operating normally with the flow sensor, which saves us time and ensures possible problems don't get out of hand."

Competitive pricing accelerates adoption

One of the most significant drivers of the recent boom in stand-alone pH and ORP controllers is pricing. Where older systems could cost thousands of dollars before installation, the newest units are far more affordable thanks to lower-cost sensors, standardized components, and more efficient manufacturing.

"So far, I have about 30 per cent of my clients who have agreed to have me install this new, simpler pH monitoring

and dosing system," says Nelson. "As newer units are priced far lower than traditional systems and help reduce chemical usage, they are much easier for technicians to recommend and homeowners to approve."

This competitive pricing dramatically shifts the conversation for pool service techs. Instead of positioning automation as a "luxury" add-on, techs



can now present it as a practical improvement that supports:

- More consistent sanitizer levels
- Lower chemical usage overall
- Fewer algae outbreaks
- Better swimmer comfort
- Protection of heaters, pumps, and salt cells

The reduced cost benefits both homeowners, who can justify the investment more easily, and technicians, who see a higher success rate when proposing automation upgrades. With a relatively small upfront investment and minimal installation time, both service companies and homeowners see fast, tangible benefits.

“I’m lucky that I have a lot of longtime customers. Once they understand how pH control improves water quality and reduces issues like scaling and algae, they are generally quick to approve the upgrade,” says Nelson.

App-based monitoring keeps water balanced between visits

Perhaps the most revolutionary aspect of these newer controllers is the integration of mobile apps, which enable real-time monitoring and alerts.

Instead of relying solely on weekly or bi-weekly service visits, technicians can monitor the chemistry fluctuations throughout the week and act proactively if anything goes out of range.

“These units just give me more peace of mind, especially because I can monitor my clients’ pools online,” says Nelson. “Remote monitoring provides early alerts about issues such as imbalanced chemistry or lack of flow, enabling technicians to address problems before they escalate.”

This integrated connectivity offers several advantages, including:

- Immediate alerts—if pH drifts high or ORP drops suddenly, maybe due to heavy bather load, rain, or a failing pump, the system can send a notification instantly. Techs can respond before the issue becomes severe.
- Reduced emergency service calls—proactive alerts reduce the chance of green water, cloudy water, scaling, and corrosive conditions. Service technicians avoid last-minute, after-hours visits.
- Better water quality between visits—the days between service appointments are when chemistry problems often begin. Remote monitoring ensures that the chemical balance remains stable throughout the week, not just on service days.
- Efficient route management—technicians can check multiple pools from the app dashboard, prioritizing which locations need attention. This reduces unnecessary trips and increases overall service efficiency.
- Customer confidence—homeowners appreciate the peace of mind that comes from knowing their pool is continuously monitored, even when no one is physically present.



Pool start-ups, too

When it comes to pools that have just been plastered or re-plastered, maintaining a perfectly balanced pH is crucial. If the pH gets out of control, it can be very problematic for the new plaster.

“My brother does pool construction, and I’ve been pushing it with him recently to try to include these, at least the pH units, as fresh plaster is highly sensitive to pH fluctuations. automated pH control helps prevent surface damage, and reduces the need for daily on-site testing.

Some builders of plaster pools ask Nelson to monitor the pH at their new job sites daily.

“But I have to tell them that I just can’t stop by daily, so instead they should include one of these new pH

sensing and dispensing units in the price of the new plaster or new pool construction, as it’s totally worth it, as it gives you eyes on the pool virtually.”

Raising the standard of residential pool care

The arrival of simple, accurate, and competitively priced stand-alone pH and ORP controllers is reshaping expectations for pool care. What was once an advanced upgrade is quickly becoming a realistic standard for residential pools.

For technicians, these controllers increase service efficiency, reduce problem pools and repeat visits, improve customer satisfaction, and offer new revenue opportunities with minimal labour. For the pool owner, these units provide consistently balanced water, fewer chemical fluctuations, reduced chemical usage, clearer pool water, and long-term equipment protection.

Today’s advancements in chemical sensing and dispensing control mark the beginning of a new era in pool maintenance—one where smart sensors and intuitive apps help ensure that every pool stays clean, safe, and perfectly balanced throughout the week. 🏊

How Software is Reshaping Pool Industry Finances

Across the pool and spa industry, there is a clear and accelerating shift toward adopting modern, software-driven technology, driven by tighter labour markets, higher customer expectations, and the need to operate more efficiently within a short seasonal window. Increasingly, businesses recognize that digital tools support greater operational control, consistency, and visibility as they scale.

Businesses often waste significant time managing paperwork, resolving scheduling conflicts, or locating misplaced invoices—inefficiencies that lead

to financial losses that manual systems struggle to track. While paperless systems were once promoted primarily for environmental reasons, they are now valued for their role in improving visibility, control, and predictability across financial operations.

The hidden cost of paper: what businesses are not tracking

Many pool and spa businesses have grown exponentially over the last five years. While manual paper systems might have been sufficient at first, as

these businesses have grown, so too has the time spent printing, filing, scanning, and searching for documents. Additionally, many in the industry report that manual systems result in lost or incomplete paperwork, duplicate data entry, and human error, all of which can lead to billing delays or customer disputes. Not to mention the drain on resources to physically store and retain records over the long term.

For some pool and spa businesses, moving from manual processes to digital systems, the strongest return on investment (ROI) typically comes from gains in labour efficiency, billing accuracy, technician productivity, inventory control, and payment collection. By eliminating double entry, automating scheduling and invoicing, tracking inventory in real time, and using tools such as online bill payments and digital work orders, many businesses reduce



Signs Manual Systems Are Costing Your Business Money

Many pool and spa businesses delay moving to paperless systems because manual processes still “work.” In practice, however, the financial impact of paper-based operations often shows up quietly and incrementally. Some common warning signs include:

- Invoices sent days—or weeks—after work is completed, delaying cash flow during peak season
- Missed billable items from service calls or change orders that never make it onto invoices
- Frequent customer billing questions or disputes caused by incomplete documentation
- Technicians returning to jobsites due to missing work orders, approvals, or customer details
- Over-ordering inventory to compensate for poor visibility into stock levels
- End-of-season write-offs from slow-moving or forgotten inventory
- Administrative bottlenecks when reconciling accounts, closing the books, or preparing for tax season

Individually, these issues may seem minor. Over a busy summer, however, they compound into lost revenue, increased labour costs, and unnecessary financial stress. For many businesses, these hidden costs exceed the annual investment required to implement integrated, paperless software systems. 🌊

operations. At the same time, understocking can result in lost sales and reduced profitability. Inventory also carries the risk of obsolescence, as products can lose value over time, affecting a company's overall financial stability.

Since the industry is highly seasonal, managers and owners need consistent visibility into inventory movement throughout the season. What is moving quickly, and what is not moving at all? This is nearly impossible to determine with manual systems. Therefore, up-to-the-minute information on all inventory, including vendor prices, is crucial for making business decisions. For example, business managers should be able to access their inventory management software module and run reports on aging and overstocked items. At the end of the season, for example, reviewing the previous year's sales trends and identifying which products have been sitting for 60-plus days helps managers prioritize them for markdowns or clearance promotions.

Selecting the Right Rails, Ladders, and Lifts

A Practical Guide for Builders, Dealers, and Operators

Pool access equipment is rarely the headline item in project specifications, yet it plays a defining role in safety, usability, compliance, and long-term operational success. When the right rails, ladders, and lifts are selected and installed thoughtfully, they make aquatic environments more inclusive and

safer for everyone. When they are not, the consequences—uncomfortable users, safety issues, costly replacements, and compliance headaches—can last for years.

For pool builders, equipment dealers, and facility operators across Canada, choosing access equipment

is about more than meeting minimum requirements. It is about making informed decisions that hold up in the real world.

Safety is the baseline—not the finish line

Safety must be the foundation for every decision about pool-access equipment. From handrails to ladders to pool lifts, every component should be evaluated for its ability to protect users in real-world

conditions. For Canadian aquatic facilities, accessibility guidance, such as the Accessible Canada CAN ASC 2.1 standard, provides a framework for designing safer environments, including recommended clear deck space, stable surfaces, and proper placement of lifts and ramps.

Safety deserves the same level of planning as any other core pool system. Access equipment performs best when selected early, positioned intentionally,





POOL ACCESS QUICK CHECKLIST

Use this as a practical reference for planning, selecting, and operating pool access equipment.

1. Codes, standards, and baselines (start here)

- Has compliance with local building codes, provincial regulations, and applicable accessibility standards been verified?
- Are there provincial or municipal guidelines that influence the type of access, placement, or clearances for this facility?
- Are recognized safety and performance standards (e.g. UL standards for powered equipment) being referenced where applicable?

2. Users and use patterns

- Who are the primary and secondary user groups for this pool (e.g. children, seniors, adaptive users, rehabilitation, general public)?
- What is the anticipated frequency and intensity of use (seasonal, daily, high-traffic, or therapeutic)?
- Will the access equipment need to serve multiple user types or programs?

3. Environment and site conditions

- Are the materials appropriate for the local environment and water chemistry (e.g. 316L stainless steel for heavily chlorinated or outdoor saltwater pools)?
- Is the pool indoor or outdoor, and how will UV exposure, freeze-thaw cycles, or weather affect the performance of the equipment?
- Are deck surfaces, slopes, and drainage compatible with safe equipment installation?

4. Equipment selection and layout

- Are handrail placement, ladder tread count, and lift positioning appropriate for the pool depth, wall configuration, and deck height?
- Does the ladder tread count align with water depth to allow safe, comfortable entry and exit?
- Is lift placement coordinated with clear deck space, transfer zones, and nearby features?
- Is the equipment compatible with existing pool structures, gutters, coping, and deck details?

5. Installation and integration

- Are the installation, anchoring, and bonding instructions complete and realistic for the facility?
- Can the equipment be installed without compromising structural integrity or waterproofing?
- Are manufacturer requirements clearly communicated to installers?

6. Operations, maintenance, and support

- Are maintenance requirements, inspection intervals, and service procedures clearly defined?
- Are replacement parts readily available in Canada?
- Does the supplier offer responsive technical support and meaningful warranty coverage?

7. Daily operations and staff readiness

- Will access equipment be available and operational during all intended operating hours?
- Have staff been trained in safe operation, emergency procedures, and routine inspections?
- Is redundancy required for high-use or public facilities?

8. Future flexibility

- Have future retrofits, expansions, or program changes been considered?
- Do removable or adjustable components enable long-term adaptability?
- Will today's choices limit future upgrades to accessibility?

and aligned with how the facility will be used. Handrails should guide movement naturally, ladders should support steady entry and exit, and lifts should be available, visible, and ready for use. When safety is prioritized during selection—not revisited after installation—access equipment becomes a dependable part of daily operations rather than a liability.

Independent testing and industry standards

Safety is not just a regulatory checkbox; it is a performance outcome. Once safety is established as a baseline principle, the next practical question is: How can one be confident that a product will perform safely and reliably over time? This is where independent testing and industry standards play an invaluable role.

In Canada, building codes and accessibility standards focus on performance outcomes—

ensuring that lifts, ladders, and rails are stable, accessible, and capable of safe operation, with appropriate clear deck space and ramp slopes. Many provincial design guidelines and industry best practices refer to recognized safety standards as a practical means of demonstrating performance, even though these standards are not legally mandated.

For example, British Columbia's pool design guidelines recommend that accessibility lifts and hoists be independently certified to recognized safety standards and installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Although this certification is not a provincial legal requirement, it reflects widely accepted design expectations and best practice for safe, reliable operation.

For builders and dealers, specifying equipment that has undergone rigorous independent evaluation assures that:

- Structural components perform as intended under load
- Controls and mechanical systems operate consistently in challenging, wet, corrosive environments
- Manufacturers have demonstrated performance beyond internal claims

For operators, third-party testing can mean fewer operational surprises, more predictable maintenance needs, and greater confidence that equipment will not fail during everyday use. Look for widely recognized third-party certifications that signal rigorous safety and performance testing, such as Underwriters Laboratories (UL). The primary UL standard applicable to electrically powered pool lifts, UL 60335-2-1000, sets safety and performance requirements for electrical safety, structural integrity, and functional reliability for both public and residential use. While adherence to UL standards is not universally required by law in Canada, products evaluated to globally recognized standards such as UL 60335-2-1000 are widely regarded as meeting a higher bar for safety, consistency, and real-world performance in aquatic environments.

Beyond the specs: Reliability and support matter

Access equipment decisions go beyond a spec sheet; they extend to long-term durability, serviceability, and manufacturer accountability. Durability and long-term reliability are equally important and depend not only on the product itself but also on the company behind it. A well-designed lift, ladder, or rail is only as




effective as the manufacturer's ability to support it throughout its life-cycle.

Durability is not guaranteed by stainless steel or corrosion-resistant coatings alone. Factors such as alloy grade, fabrication quality, weld integrity, and the ability to withstand the specific environment—outdoor exposure, saltwater, or heavily chlorinated pools—all affect how a product performs over time. That is where quality management systems, such as ISO 9001:2015 certification, become critical. ISO is not a product certification; it is a structured approach to ensuring that a manufacturer consistently produces products that meet defined quality standards. Facilities that specify equipment from manufacturers with recognized quality processes are more likely to receive equipment that performs reliably, installation after installation.

Long-term reliability also depends on how a company stands behind its product. A warranty is only as strong as the people who honour it. When evaluating potential suppliers, ask about:

- Warranty coverage and limitations
- Availability of replacement parts in Canada
- Technical support responsiveness
- Installation guidance and training resources
- Ongoing maintenance recommendations

Choosing products from companies with strong quality management practices and robust support ensures the investment continues to deliver value throughout the years of operation. It also reduces unexpected downtime, maintenance headaches, and safety risks, protecting both users and operators.

Practical guidance: Choosing the right equipment for a project

This section offers actionable guidance for builders, dealers, and operators when specifying and selecting pool access equipment. By considering the specific environment, user needs, and operational context, informed choices can be made that optimize safety, usability, and durability.



Handrails: Support where it matters

- Ergonomic placement for continuous support from deck to water
- Anchor type and material selection appropriate for the deck surface and water chemistry
- Multibend or extended rails for enhanced stability and accessibility
- Use custom, adjustable rails for unique pool edges or retrofits
- Material selection appropriate for long-term environmental exposure (e.g. 316L marine-grade stainless steel is recommended for heavily chlorinated or outdoor saltwater pools)

Pool ladders: Balancing safety and comfort

- Select the appropriate tread type for the intended use
- Ensure handhold continuity for secure entry and exit
- Consider cross-braced ladders for commercial or high-traffic pools
- Select a tread count appropriate to pool depth, ensuring the ladder has enough rungs for safe, comfortable deck-to-water entry and exit (many guidelines specify a minimum of four rungs in deeper water)
- Select material appropriate to environmental exposure (e.g. 316L marine-grade stainless steel is recommended for heavily chlorinated or outdoor saltwater pools)

Pool lifts: Matching equipment to users and layout

- Consider water depth, deck height, required setback range, and proximity to other features
- Controls should be intuitive and accessible from the deck and the water, where possible
- Placement should allow for clear deck space and safe and secure transfers

- Ensure the seat height is 406 to 483 mm (16 to 19 in.) above the deck for wheelchair transfers
- Pool lifts should be readily available to users during operating hours

Co-ordinated access planning

- Ensure logical circulation between entry points, decks, and water
- Consider planning multiple access points to reduce congestion
- Maintain barrier-free paths from changing rooms to pool edges
- Provide redundancy to improve safety and usability in high-use or public facilities

Installation, training, and ongoing operations

Even well-chosen equipment requires ongoing attention after installation. Clear installation instructions, routine inspection protocols, and staff training ensure railings are secure, ladders remain stable, and lifts are ready for use.

Documented maintenance schedules and accessible technical support help facilities maintain safety and uptime over years of operation.

Conclusion: Better decisions lead to better aquatic experiences

For Canadian aquatic professionals, choosing access equipment is both a technical and operational responsibility. Safety, durability, and long-term support should be considered from the outset. By specifying thoughtfully designed products, prioritizing independent testing and quality management, and partnering with manufacturers who stand behind their equipment, operators and builders can create aquatic environments that are safe, reliable, and easier to manage over time. Ultimately, accessibility works best when it is baked in rather than bolted on. 🦜

The Hidden Lifeline of Aquatic Facilities

Why Preventive Maintenance Protects Community Access

Every community pool has a story. Some hold memories of early-morning swim practices. Some are where children take their first strokes. Others are gathering places where seniors stay active and connected. These facilities shape daily life more than most people realize, yet their long-term success

depends on something that often receives far less attention than construction or programming. That quiet foundation is preventive maintenance.

Preventive maintenance in aquatic facilities means taking a proactive, scheduled approach to caring for pools, equipment, and water systems—



Scheduled assessments and routine servicing support stable water quality, efficient system performance, and fewer emergency repairs.

before problems occur. Rather than reacting to failures, closures, or safety issues, preventive maintenance focuses on regular inspections, testing, cleaning, adjustments, and component servicing to keep systems operating efficiently and safely.

In practice, this includes routine water quality monitoring, equipment checks, filter and pump maintenance, chemical system calibration, and early detection of wear or imbalance. The result is fewer

emergency repairs, reduced downtime, longer equipment life, safer water conditions, and more predictable operating costs, helping facilities remain open, compliant, and reliable for their users.

The reality is simple. A pool that is not maintained cannot serve its community. When a facility goes offline unexpectedly, the impact ripples far beyond the mechanical room. Athletes lose training time. Families lose swim lessons. Recreation departments

Five early warning signs every facility should monitor

1. Sudden changes in water clarity

Cloudiness often indicates filtration issues, circulation imbalance, or chemical inconsistency. Early attention prevents larger water quality problems.

Operators should pair visual checks with consistent testing protocols, as many water quality and equipment issues develop well before they become visible. Combining routine inspections with documented testing provides a more reliable, compliant, and proactive approach to facility management.

2. Pumps drawing more power than usual

Higher amperage or unusual vibration can indicate mechanical stress. Addressing it early can prevent complete pump failure.

The most effective tools include basic motor current monitors, variable frequency drive (VFD) readouts, and simple vibration sensors or handheld vibration meters.

3. Rising filter pressure readings

A gradual rise in pressure often indicates blockages or overdue cleaning. Efficient filtration depends on prompt action.

Rising filter pressure should trigger immediate intervention when readings increase by eight to 10 PSI above the established clean baseline or change rapidly over a short period. Acting at this point helps prevent flow loss, water quality issues, and unnecessary strain on pumps and equipment.

4. Inconsistent chemical consumption

Sharp increases or decreases in chemical use can reveal malfunctions in feed systems, sensor issues, or new environmental factors affecting the water.

Facilities can distinguish between these by comparing current readings against established baselines and historical trends rather than relying on single data points. Seasonal changes tend to be gradual and predictable, while true system issues show abnormal or accelerating deviations that do not align with past patterns.

5. Temperature or humidity fluctuations in the mechanical room

Hotter or more humid conditions than usual can degrade equipment performance and accelerate wear. Monitoring the space helps protect system components.

For commercial aquatic mechanical rooms, best practice is to maintain temperatures between 16–29 C (60–85 F) and keep relative humidity below 60 per cent. Sustained conditions outside these ranges can accelerate corrosion, shorten equipment lifespan, and increase the risk of electrical or control system issues. 🌊

lose trust. These disruptions are preventable when facilities shift from reacting to problems to anticipating them.

A common avoidable shutdown occurs when a chemical feeder slowly clogs or degrades, reducing



chlorine output until water chemistry falls out of compliance and the pool is forced to close. With proactive maintenance, routine inspections, and cleaning, the issue can be identified early and corrected before it affects water chemistry. The result is fewer emergency closures, safer water, and uninterrupted operations.

What operators see behind the scenes

Unlike most public amenities, aquatic systems operate continuously. Pumps move thousands of gallons of water. Filters remove contaminants throughout the day. Chemical feed systems adjust constantly to maintain balance. Each part works in an environment where moisture, heat, and pressure are constant.

Aquatic systems are uniquely demanding because they operate continuously in a corrosive environment where water quality directly affects public health. Unlike most municipal assets (such as buildings and parks), pools rely on tightly balanced mechanical and chemical systems that must perform consistently to remain open and compliant.

This makes aquatic facilities uniquely vulnerable to small issues that can escalate quickly. A chemical imbalance may begin as a minor adjustment but can lead to surface degradation. A subtle change in pump performance may signal mechanical wear. A filtration system running harder than usual may be compensating for unseen blockages.

Operators who recognize these early indicators tend to face fewer emergencies. They also plan more



routine equipment inspections, and trend tracking of pressure, flow, and chemical demand. Ongoing staff training ensures teams recognize subtle changes before they become failures, while service reports and performance data help reveal patterns over time. Together, these tools turn day-to-day observations into actionable insights that prevent disruptions.

Routine inspections, cleaning, and adjustments performed by maintenance staff help keep aquatic systems operating safely, efficiently, and without disruption.

The value of scheduled assessments

Scheduled assessments give facility leaders a comprehensive understanding of how their systems are performing. These evaluations establish measurable benchmarks that make it easier to spot changes over time.

Scheduled assessments are typically performed quarterly, while higher-use or competitive facilities benefit from weekly or monthly evaluations. Frequency often varies by facility size, bather load, and programming intensity, with heavier usage requiring more frequent review to maintain performance and compliance.

effectively, communicate more clearly, and deliver more reliable service to their communities.

Operators most effectively identify early warning signs through consistent water testing and logging.

Reliable preventive maintenance helps ensure aquatic facilities remain open, safe, and available for the programs and communities that depend on them.

Assessments support:

- More stable water quality
- More efficient system performance
- Fewer unexpected closures
- Clearer long-term financial planning

Most importantly, they help operators identify patterns before they become problems. When paired with routine servicing and accurate record-keeping, these assessments form the backbone of a healthy aquatic facility.

Accurate record-keeping in aquatic facilities involves consistently documenting water chemistry readings, equipment performance, maintenance actions, and inspections in a clear and organized log. These records enable operators to identify trends, demonstrate compliance, and make informed decisions before small issues escalate into major problems.

Preparing for seasonal demands

Seasonal shifts place extra stress on equipment. Recreation centres that experience heavy summer use often prepare by reviewing system capacity, inspecting mechanical components, and verifying that everything is operating as intended before attendance surges.

Commonly missed tasks include:

- Pre-season calibration of feeders and chemical systems, which can contribute to early-season chemistry instability
- Pump seal, gasket, and O-ring inspections, which may fail under increased summer demand
- Filter media inspection and cleaning, particularly before peak bather loads
- Heat exchanger and heater servicing ahead of seasonal temperature shifts
- Winterization planning or de-winterization checks, depending on climate and facility type

Addressing these items seasonally helps prevent breakdowns during peak operating periods, when downtime is most disruptive. This preparation also prevents mid-season interruptions and protects the programs that rely on consistent access.

Facilities that plan seasonally experience fewer emergency closures, lower repair costs, and more consistent water quality, while those that do not often face reactive fixes, higher downtime, and avoidable budget surprises.

Planning ahead protects budgets

Every operator knows how disruptive unplanned repairs can be. They are costly, difficult to schedule, and often require immediate action. Long-term forecasting helps facility leaders anticipate when major components may reach the end of their useful life. This enables thoughtful budgeting, fewer surprises, and transparent communication with boards, councils, and stakeholders.

Commonly underestimated components include chemical feed systems, circulation pumps, filter media, heaters, and control systems, all of which experience continuous wear in harsh aquatic environments. Facility finishes, such as decking, grates, and pool surfaces, are also often overlooked despite their direct impact on safety, compliance, and long-term capital planning.

Forecasting also helps communities understand the full life-cycle of their aquatic investment. It allows leaders to weigh capital needs with clarity rather than urgency.

Operators can communicate life-cycle costs most effectively by linking equipment condition and replacement timelines to clear impacts on safety, uptime, and budget risk.

Why consistency builds community confidence

Pools are more than infrastructure. They are public commitments. When they operate consistently, they demonstrate reliability. When closures become frequent, confidence begins to erode.

Facilities that operate reliably and avoid unexpected closures consistently see higher community participation, stronger program enrolment, and greater public trust.

Preventive maintenance safeguards the programs people count on, including:



teams, and leadership all contribute to a facility's stability. Construction may make a pool possible, but maintenance is what keeps it a resource for decades.

Leadership teams can support maintenance staff by prioritizing preventive maintenance, providing proper training and tools, and establishing clear communication pathways that align daily operations with long-term facility goals.

As maintenance programs mature, many facilities are rethinking how preventive maintenance is carried out. Emerging technologies and practices are changing how aquatic facilities monitor performance, identify issues, and maintain long-term reliability.

Commercial facilities are seeing measurable improvements through automated self-monitoring of water quality, advanced filtration systems that reduce manual intervention, and more structured inspection programs. Tools such as QR code-based access to inspection records or service information

help teams identify issues earlier and improve overall system reliability.

Reliable aquatic programs depend on reliable aquatic systems. Preventive maintenance is the quiet structure that keeps the doors open and the water moving. ♪

A 4.4- x 2.1-m (14.5- x 7-ft) Ipe wood deck gives older kids a launchpad for cannonballs, while adults enjoy the soothing sound of LED water sheers or test their strength against the built-in Badu jet. Surrounding stonework, full flagstone surfacing, and an elevated 4.9- x 6.1-m (16- x 20-ft) dining deck add structure and style. A fully equipped outdoor kitchen with bar seating completes the space, while smart automation lets the owners control everything with ease.
